GendA - Netzwerk feministische Arbeitsforschung" beschäftigt sich aus

genderorientierter und feministischer Sicht mit der Konzeption und der Gestaltung von "Arbeit" und ihrer wissenschaftlichen Bearbeitung. Das Anliegen von GendA ist deshalb, auf der Basis feministischer Kritik und den daraus folgenden feministischen Erkenntnissen die vorhandenen Lücken der traditionellen Arbeitsforschung zu füllen. Dabei soll deutlich werden, wo es einer grundlegenden Re-Konstruktion und einer Re-Vision des gesamten Gegenstandsbereiches der Arbeitsforschung, des ihr zugrunde liegenden Arbeitsbegriffs, ihrer Fragestellungen und ihrer Methodologie bedarf und wie diese aussehen könnten.
